



Sacrament of Confirmation Letter of Intent Packet

January 2019

Dear High School Teens and Parents,

All teens who are interested in receiving the sacrament of Confirmation are invited to officially enroll in the immediate preparation for the sacrament. This preparation can be done once the teen (or candidate) has completed the requirements indicated in the L.I.G.H.T. guidebook.

Candidates who have completed the necessary requirements should complete the "Letter of Intent for the Sacrament of Confirmation" form AND the "Course and Retreat Registration" form included with this letter. Candidates should choose a sponsor and Confirmation name before they return this form. This information needs to be included on the form (details on both of these is included).

Once candidates have returned the letter of intent (***The absolute Deadline is Monday, February 25, 2019***), they will be asked to attend the Orientation Seder Meal & Potluck Dinner on Sunday, March 10, 2019 from 2:00 to 4:45 PM in the Parish Life Center. This meeting is required for the candidate, sponsor and at least one parent. A Candidate and Sponsor Guidebook will be given out at this meeting.

The 5 week preparation course begins the week of April 7th. For those teens who have not yet completed Harvest Saturday, that event will be held on April 27th. The Discovery Retreats will be held during summer (2 will be offered). Please use the enclosed form for registration for both the Confirmation prep course and retreat.

The last step before receiving the sacrament will be a short 15 minute Interview. This will be done in August or September and include the candidate, sponsor (or a parent can stand in for the sponsor) as well as the interviewer (a member of the L.I.G.H.T. team and parish).

Finally, the rehearsal and ceremony will be planned for the fall, usually in October or November. Details on this will be given out once we receive our date from the Bishop.

Information on Choosing a Confirmation Name & Sponsor

CHOOSING A SPONSOR

The Candidate must choose a sponsor before entering the preparation program. The sponsor **MUST** be a confirmed, practicing Catholic who is at least 16 years of age. **The sponsor may NOT be the father or mother of the Candidate.** When feasible, the Candidate's baptismal sponsor (God Parents) may be chosen as the Confirmation sponsor.

We urge the Candidate to choose someone who lives nearby so he or she can participate in the program along with the Candidate and lend spiritual support to the Candidate in the coming years. Sponsors are asked to attend the Opening Session/Seder Meal (for Candidates, parents and Sponsor), the Interview, Rehearsal, and Confirmation Ceremony.

Sponsors are encouraged to meet frequently with the Candidate to share in the preparation process. The name, address, and parish of the sponsor should be documented on the Sacrament of Confirmation Intent Form. Sponsors will also be given a handbook at the Opening Session/Seder Meal to guide in their role as sponsor.

CHOOSING A CONFIRMATION NAME

A Candidate must choose a Confirmation name before entering the preparation program. A name identifies us in a unique way, not just our physical selves, but who we are as person. One of the traditional practices in the Church at the time of Confirmation is choosing a name that will remind you of this sacrament. Your prayerful reflection will help you determine that name. You might want to recommit yourself to your Baptismal name since it expresses the relationship that exists between these two sacraments, especially after you reflect on its meaning and discover some of the people who shared your name in Christian history.

You might want to choose the name of a saint who represents the type of Christian you wish to be. It is important to learn as much as you can about your patron saint. After all, you are asking this saint to be your friend and advocate for the rest of your life.

Whether you decide to stay with your Baptismal name or pick a new name, take the time to research and explore the root meaning of the name, for as Scripture says "Yahweh calls each of us by name." The name should be documented on the Sacrament of Confirmation Intent Form.
