- 1. All volunteers are scheduled in advance.
- 2. As a courtesy to ministry volunteers and those we serve, please do not volunteer if you are ill/unwell.
- 3. Notify the Coordinator promptly when unable to keep your commitment due to illness/emergency, to enable a substitute to be found.
- 4. Arrive on time at your scheduled shift.
- 5. Since our volunteer numbers exceed the serving spots available, you may be enlisted to serve on alternate months.

Volunteers serving at the Hesed House shelter:

- 6. Check-in at the digital sign-in kiosk before beginning your shift
- 7. New volunteers are required to fill out a basic volunteer profile on the Hesed House system when you arrive at the shelter (this is required for Health Department purposes, as well as for volunteer protection in the event of emergency).
